





RIGA: Latvian director Dāvis Sīmanis has begun principal shooting of the Latvian/Lithuanian/Czech coproduction The Year before



The summer shooting period began on 19 May 2019 and is expected to finish in early July. The whole production period of the film will include 33 shooting days. Five days of winter shooting were completed in early February in Latvia (Pļaviņas, Rīga and Talsi). The summer shooting will take place on location in Latvia (Riga, Cinevillage, Zvārtava, Krimulda, Stāmeriena, Cēsis) and in the Czech Republic.

The historical thriller, and the third fiction film for Simanis, is a reminder to contemporary society about the turbulent times before WWI. Using the stylisation of silent cinema, the film connects political and philosophical extremes of 1913, telling the story of a young man participating in the creation of a new world. A mysterious adventurer, who was known as Peter the Lett. gets involved







role, alongside Latvian actors Lauris Dzelzītis, Gints Grāvelis, Ģirts Ķesteris and Dace Everss.

The Year Before the War is produced by Roberts Vinovskis at Locomotive Productions (Latvia) in coproduction with Studio Uljana Kim (Lithuania) and Produkce Radim Prochazka (Czech Republic). The project is supported by the film institutions in all three coproduction countries, with the largest financing amount from the National Film Centre of Latvia, 502,662 EUR. The estimated budget is 850,000 EUR.

The expected release date is the autumn of 2020.



Therefore, considering all the awards and praises "Honeyland" has gotten so far, it is safe to say that 2019 was a successful year for North Macedonia's film industry. In addition to Honeyland "s wide international success, two other movies were highly acclaimed – "God Exists, Her Name is Petrunya "and "Willow "."

A great year for domestic films

According to the specialised website Film New Europe , 2019 was a great year for the Macedonian film industry, both domestically and internationally. Also, the Film Agency reached a similar conclusion. "Macedonian cinematography achieved remarkable success in 2019, especially in the field of majority coproductions and documentaries. On the international level, the year was marked with worldwide distribution for domestic titles and their participation in more than 200 film festival selections, and over 60 awards", Fund's publication Facts & Figures .

The cumulative data collected so far by the Agency show that Honeyland has been screened in more than 50 film festivals worldwide, scooping more than 20 awards – most importantly three awards at 2019 Sundance Festival, alongside a nomination in the documentary category of the European Film Awards and two Oscar nominations.

The feminist satire "God Exists, Her Name is Petrunya", by Teona Strugar Mitevska, had its world premiere in the Competition programme at the 2019 Berlin Film Festival. It was selected for over 70 festivals and won 25 awards. It also received the Prize of the Ecumenical Jury at the 2019 Berlinale, and the European Parliament

Renowned Macedonian director Milcho Manchevski's sixth feature film "Willow" had its world premiere at the Rome Film Festival in October 2019. Since then, it has enjoyed a rich festival life with several festival selections for 2020.



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



SXSW Short Film 'Stucco'

Dito Tsintsadze's story of the courageous self-sacrifice of village fighters in the Russian-Georgian war of August 2008 was shot in the location of a real battle.

Georgia has selected Dito Tsintsadze's war film Shindisi as its entry for the best international feature category (formerly foreign language film) in the 92nd Academy Awards.



The pic, based on a true story, chronicles the Russian-Georgian war of August 2008 by focusing on the fate of 17 soldiers killed in a battle that took place in the small village of Shindisi. They died to enable 25 comrades to escape to safety after a Russian military unit broke a local truce.

Shot on location in the village, just a decade after the end of the brief summer war — which saw Russian armored columns come within a few miles of the Georgian capital of Tbilisi — the film was scripted by Irakli Solomanashvili. The cast includes Goga Pipinashvili, Davit Bakhtadze, Tamuna Abshilava and Marim Jibladze.

Shindisi was produced by Georgia's 20 Steps Productions in co-production with Free Movie Studio (Georgia) and the financial support of the Georgian National Film Center. The film's producers are Vladimir Katcharava, Edmond Minashvili and Konstantin Esadze.

Minashvili says that August remains for him "the most cold and frosty month" as it reminds him of August 2008 when he heard "about the death of my old friend, a great patriot and talented poet, Mikhail Dvalishvili, who gave his life on the battlefield of Shindisi."




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
