# 33<sup>rd</sup> Polish Film Festival in Gdynia

The author of this year's poster is Andrzej Pałowski, one of the most recognizable Polish artists who has published over a thousand posters in Poland and abroad. He has won dozens of national and international awards, e.g., Hollywood Reporter Award in Los Angeles and Silver Plaque Award in Chicago.

Andrzej Pałowski also illustrates books and newspapers, creates record plates covers, scenography in theatres and television productions, screenplays of films and music videos.

### Music from film

Traditionally, not only film enthusiasts but also music lovers will find plenty of interesting events during the Festival. This year we have the pleasure of inviting you to film music concerts which will take place in Teatr Miejski in Gdynia at 7 p.m.

16 September - Vadim Brodski and Cappella Gedanensis with jazz trio: Konstanty Wileński – piano and orchestration, Tomasz Kupiec – double bass, Piotr Biskupski – drums;

18 September - Henryk Kuźniak film music (from “Vabank”, “Seksmisja”, “Na kłopoty Bednarski”) performed by Polish Baltic Philharmonic conducted by Janusz Powolny.

### Film School in Łódź - in Gdynia

During 33<sup>rd</sup> Polish Film Festival in Gdynia the Film School in Łódź will celebrate its 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary, and the Silesian Film Department its 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary. The celebration will be accompanied by short films screenings, archival films screenings, exhibition of artistic photos by students of Photography Department of the Film School and history of the Film School presented by the students and professors in their photos. A special session connected with the influence of film schools on Polish cinematography will take place. Everyone will be able to take part in a short film at a special stand with the books and films on DVD produced by the Film School.

### Accompanying events

Screenings on the Beach, exhibitions, special screenings, films for children – these are just examples of accompanying events which will be held at 33<sup>rd</sup> Polish Film Festival in Gdynia. Children will have their film meetings entitled “Gdynia for Children” with screenings of films for the youngest audience, not only from Poland.

Apart from that, there will be at least three exhibitions: “Maestro Fellini”, “Pola Negri” and an exhibition of “Film” magazine.

“Screenplay Laboratory” and will be held and “Wind from the sea” series of screenings outside cinemas. Special screenings of films with audiodescription will allow the blind to watch the films as well.
